Old Northern Road resurfacing

The resurfacing of Old Northern Road has always been one of my highest priorities for Everton.

After extensive improvement works, I am proud to announce that the worst sections of the road have now been resealed.

Further rehabilitation of this main thoroughfare will now continue on South Pine Road and Old Northern Road, between Stafford Road and Rogers Parade East.

These continued works will provide a safer and smoother surface for drivers and ensure the longevity of the road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, works will be carried out between 7pm and 5am, Monday to Friday through to mid April.

Nearby residents should have already been directly informed by the Department of Transport and Main Roads of construction details.

Old Northern Road Noise Barrier Project



Albany Creek residents will soon benefit from reduced noise with the construction of noise barriers along Old Northern Road between Hamilton Road and the Jinker Track.

After community consultation, revised plans are underway. The department will be directly in contact with nearby residents informing them of upcoming developments.

I thank the local residents for their patience in what has been a long process.

South Pine Road & Stafford Road intersection

I will be lobbying the current government to allocate money in the next state budget to upgrade the South Pine Road and Stafford Road intersection.

This intersection is now one of the worst traffic bottlenecks in the North West. The Everton Park Woolworths development is only going to exacerbate the current frustration for motorists.

An intersection upgrade is one of my highest priorities for the Everton electorate.
