### No more repairs for eyesore fencing

A regular inspection of Old Northern Rd/South Pine Rd prompted State Member for Everton, Tim Mander to request some maintenance work along this road.

Mr Mander said “With 52,000 vehicles using this road every day, it is important that the department prioritises safety for maintenance work. The comfort of local residents must also be considered.”

“The hotchpotch timber fencing along South Pine Road opposite the Eatons Hill Tavern is an eyesore and is no longer effective for the residents who live behind it. In the past two years, I have requested repairs four times to this section of fencing,” he said.

TMR has inspected this fencing and deemed it is beyond repair. Instead they will consider alternative fencing but any replacement fencing has not been budgeted by the Palaszczuk government.

They have repaired broken panels for the timber fencing between Wruck Crescent and Faheys Road.

TMR have also advised they will clean the median strip on Old Northern Road between Faheys Road and Dargie Street in the coming weeks.
